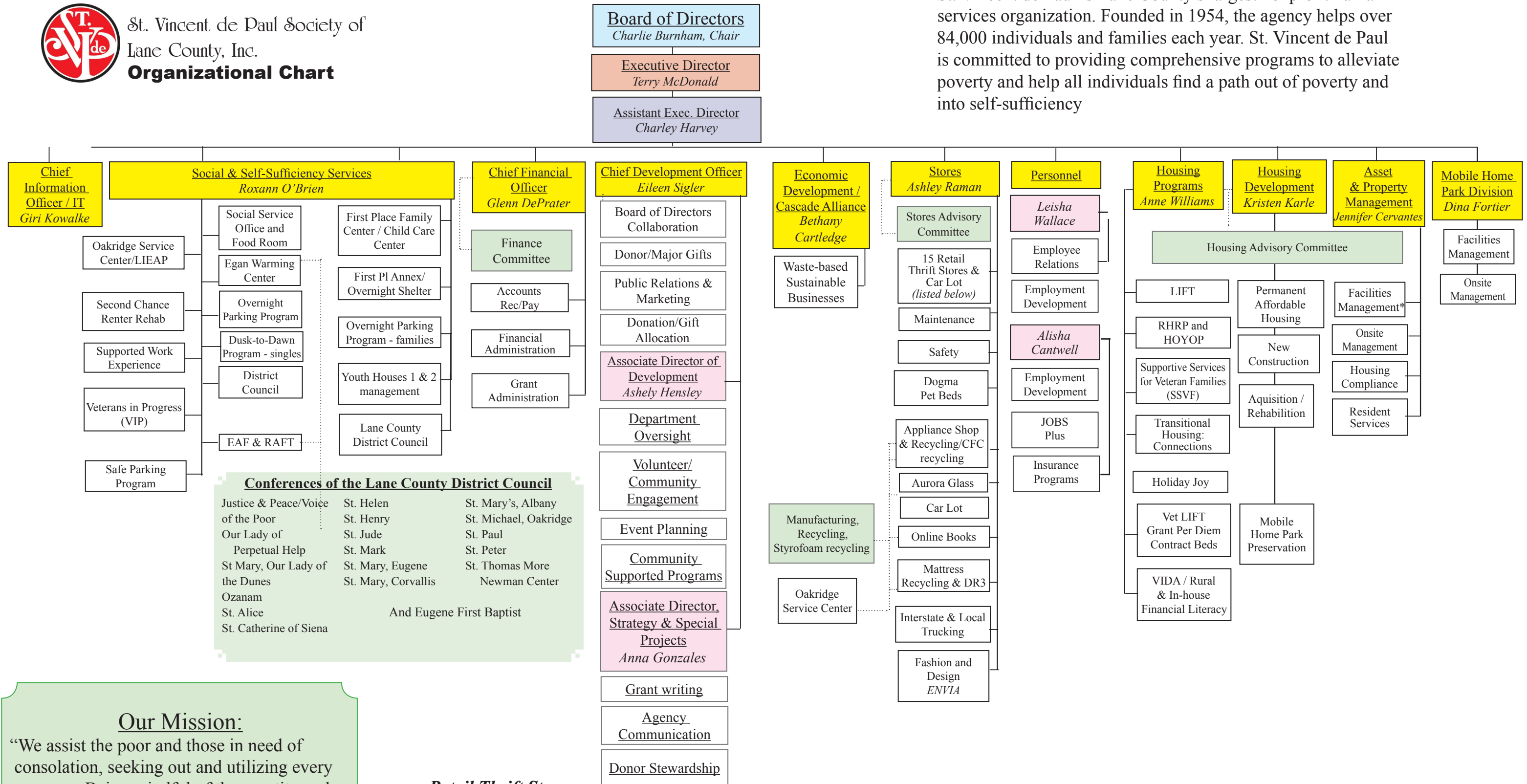




St. Vincent de Paul Society of Lane County, Inc.
