## **Other Sponsorship Opportunities**



**Emergency, Youth & Family Services:** SVdP provides life-stabilizing services to families with children younger than 18, including overnight and day shelter, free onsite childcare, and emergency services. We offer wraparound case management to support the unique needs of families experiencing homlessness as well as essential needs such as food, warmth, laundry, showers and hygiene supplies. *Sponsor levels*:

- Sponsor childcare for unhoused family, \$200/month or \$2,500/year
- Sponsor day-service essentials for unhoused families, \$500/month or \$3,000/year
- Sponsor overnight shelter for one family, \$2,000/month or \$6,000/90 days



<u>**Our Residents:**</u> SVdP manages more than 1,700 affordable-housing units in 40+ properties and individual houses across Oregon. We serve veterans, seniors, adults with disabilities, and low-income families. In addition to providing a safe place to live, we employ Resident Services Coordinators to build strong communities by providing enriching socializing activities and children's after-school experiences. *Sponsor levels*:

- Adopt a community: Sponsor a program at one property, \$500/month or \$6,000/year
- Provide stability & essentials: Sponsor emergency supply closets, \$1,000/month or \$12,000/year
- Enhance adult or childrens programs: like classes or garden projects, \$3,000/month or \$36,000/year



**Our Fleet:** SVdP operates 474 trucks, trailers, passenger cars and other vehicles that are in use across the agency every day. You can keep us moving by sponsoring our existing equipment or helping us acquire new vehicles as we grow. *Sponsor levels*:

- Program vehicle: \$500/month or \$6,000/year
- Donation truck or trailer: \$3,000/month or \$36,000/year
- Fleet: \$10,000/month or \$120,000/year
- Wish list item: Tow truck, \$120,000
